WHAT IS INVOLVED IN BECOMING A COMMITTEE MEMBER

1. Positions on the Management Committee are open to all residents who are Share Members. Our Committee is made up of 13 residents from the local area, with an additional 2 positions made available for Councillors from West Dunbartonshire Council.
2. If the Association's Committee is full (15 members) your name will be placed on a waiting list and will go forward at the next Annual General Meeting. If a vacancy arises beforehand your application will be considered by the Management Committee.
3. If you are elected to the Management Committee you will receive induction training, and ongoing training will be available to you for as long as you serve on the Committee.
4. The full Committee meets on the first Tuesday of every month, and if you choose to attend additional meetings, the Housing Services Sub-Committee and the Finance Sub-Committee meet on the second Tuesday of most months.
5. The Management Committee and Sub-Committees discuss the Association's policies, performance and overall objectives. As a Committee Member you can ensure that your views are taken into account when policy decisions are being made, as it is important to Knowes that all groups of the community are represented.
6. As a Share Member, you can vote at the Annual General Meeting, and you are eligible to stand for election to the Management Committee.
